### **Responsibilities:**

- Provides individual, play and family therapy to Spanish and English speaking families who have children experiencing emotional and behavioral difficulties. Experience working with early childhood-aged children is strongly preferred.
- Works as part of a multidisciplinary team including psychologists, social workers, and clinicians to ensure continuity and quality of care and services.
- Attends planning and training meetings to contribute to the implementation and development of programs.
- Works collaboratively with team members to ensure continuity of care and services.
- Initiates individual or team consultation as needed.
- Enters daily appointments in client database and keeps schedule up to date.
- Maintains and organizes clinical charts with current treatment plans, progress notes and other documentation required by clinical licensure.
- Collects initial and follow-up program surveys.
- Keep informed of developments in theory and practice through in-house opportunities for continuous education.
- Comfort providing presentations for small to mid-sized audiences about clinical and intersection work.
