Professional Responsibilities:

- Provides individual, group and family therapy to families (primarily those enrolled in Momentous School) who have children experiencing emotional and behavioral difficulties.
- Works closely with Momentous School administration and teachers to create and evaluate solutions at the intersection of education and mental health. This includes:
 - Conducting classroom observations
 - Providing teacher consultations for individual students, classes, or grade levels
 - Relationship-building with teaching and clinical staff members
 - Working with the Director of Therapeutic Services to capture what the agency is learning from our internal intersection work.
- Works as part of a multidisciplinary team including psychologists, social workers, and clinicians to ensure continuity and quality of care and services.
- Attends planning and training meetings to contribute to the implementation & development of programs.
- Works collaboratively with team members to ensure continuity of care and services.
- Initiates individual or team consultation as needed.
- Maintains expected case load and stewardship levels.
- Enters daily appointments in client database and keeps schedule up to date.
- Maintains and organizes clinical charts with current treatment plans, progress notes and other documentation required by clinical licensure.
- Uses the Systemic Therapy Inventory of Change (STIC) on all eligible clients as well as other relevant research methods.
- Keeps informed of developments in theory and practice through internal & external PD opportunities.
- Participate in expanding our reach efforts by sharing our work with other professionals via trainings.

- Performs other duties as assigned by Therapeutic Services Program Director.

- Minimum of a Master's degree in behavioral sciences from an accredited university with a Texas License to practice therapy. Supervisory experience a plus.
