**Role:** Psychologist who will provide direct services to children, adolescents and families as well as supervision and training to doctoral psychology interns as part an APA-Accredited Internship, and also to postdoctoral psychology fellows.

### **Professional Responsibilities:**

- Provide assessment, psychotherapy (individual, family, couples and/or group) and testing services to children, adolescents and families in a multidisciplinary outpatient setting. Therefore, some clinical interventions may be provided in the community in collaboration with agency partners.
- Supervise the clinical and administrative work of psychology trainees, including supervision of both therapy and assessment.

- Provide trainings (in the community and internally) on topics relevant to the field of child/family mental health
- Provide consultation services to Momentous Institute School to facilitate effective interventions for behavioral and academic needs faced by students.
